THT Board would like to thank you for the great support provided last year with your donations, volunteer hours, participation in various religious, outreach and fundraising activities that made 2022 a very successful year. We would like to highlight here the impact of your donations and upcoming needs of our temple.

- On the construction front, We have completed 3 Garbhalayams and placed orders for precast walls propelling us closer to our dream Temple. Our Temple assets have grown to 3M from 400K in the last 4 years which would not be possible without your support. With key improvements in the temple premises, Our ability to serve the community has expanded.
- Newly built temple parking lot has become the place of confluence of different cultures, cuisine and traditions. Thanks to grand success of Food Festival engaging over 100 volunteers from 10 different Indian states serving delicacies and raising awareness towards Temple Construction to over 3000 visitors. Please join us on April 22, 2023 for a similar event to raise awareness on construction.
- With diligent efforts of temple finance team, We received 488K from Federal EIDL loan. These funds are restricted for use to Operational expenses.
- Your support and participation helped us initiate new celebrations like Paush Bada, Panguni Uthiram, Phoolon ki Holi, Bhagavathi Puja, Tulsi Puja, Dandiya and Dosa Night, Donor Appreciation Night and Independence day Celebrations. Our **Srivarī Kalyana Utsavam** recreated Tirumala Kalyana Utsavam in the community by our priest. We look forward to bringing such authentic, religious experience to you this year with your continued support.
- Our community outreach activities such as Balavihar, Free Yoga, Food bank, Blood bank, Soup Kitchen, Presidential Volunteer Service Awards program, continued to roll at a steady pace.
- Spiritual Satsang Sessions, Gita Discussions, Bhajans, Lalitha Sahasranama Discussions were conducted.
- Our temple has also seen great engagement from local scout troops, young volunteers to maintain temple premises and garden. We request your kids to make use of these opportunities and engage in Seva.
- Our monthly ach increased to 5.5K/Month, We would want to increase it to 10K by the end of the year to position us strong for new loan commitments which is expected to be paid off in 10 years.

Temple Needs for 2023:

- **Volunteers Needed:** With ever increasing line up of temple events to accommodate various needs of community members, Our need for volunteers has grown more than ever.
- With Precast Walls for the entire structure been ordered, temple is in immediate need of 500K for its installation and completion of the structure with roof in 3 months. **We need your support more than ever in this critical juncture to complete the temple without any delays.**
- Our temple has also initiated community loan program for lending 50K at an interest rate of 4%, 10 year term with a promissory note. Our community members have started a campaign to raise 500K in 3 months by seeking to raise 1K from 500 donors immediately by end of April. Samuhika Parayanam has been initiated to increase awareness and seek support of people beyond triad community. Please contact to help with various fundraising campaigns.
