THT Board would like to thank you for the great support provided this year with your donations, volunteer hours, participation in various religious, outreach and fundraising activities that made 2023 a very successful year. We would like to highlight here the impact of your donations and upcoming needs of our temple.

- On the construction front, We have erected precast walls propelling us closer to our dream Temple. - Our parking lot has become the place of confluence of different cultures, cuisine and traditions. Thanks to grand success of Food Festival engaging over 100 volunteers from 10 different Indian states serving delicacies and raising awareness towards Temple Construction to over 2000 visitors. Please join us on April 20th, 2024 for a similar event to raise awareness on construction.
- Your support and participation helped us initiate **Dasa Laksha Rama Nama Parayanam** that involved more than 300 families to participate from USA and from mutts in India. We plan to have another such grand religious event on Jan 20/21, 2024 coinciding with the consecration of Rama temple in Ayodhya. We celebrated Raavan Dahan for the first time during Dussehra.
- On Thanksgiving day, Several homeless families were fed by Temple Volunteers. We had reached out to elderly in the community thanking them and continue to reach out to as many families tied to Triad Hindu Temple. Our other community outreach activities such as Balavihar, Free Yoga, Food bank, Soup Kitchen, Presidential Volunteer Service Awards program, continued to roll at a steady pace.
- Triad Hindu Temple has strengthened its collaboration with temples, religious and dharmic organizations in the area. It has partnered with Interfaith organizations, participating in Stranger to Neighbour program, partnering with Greensboro Police Dept and has raised awareness on service done by the temple community and increased awareness on the richness of Hindu Culture and Heritage.
- Spiritual Satsang Sessions, Gita Discussions, Bhajans, Lalitha Sahasranama Discussions were conducted.
- Great stalwarts like Padmabushan Sudha Raghunathan, Youth Icon Soorya Gayathri and celebrated musicians like Vignesh Ishwar visited the area to raise awareness on Temple Construction with their concerts.
- Our monthly ach increased to 8K/Month, We would want to increase it to 10K by the end of the year to position us strong for new loan commitments which is expected to be paid off in 10 years.
- Thanks to your support to THT Annual fundraising dinner. 61K funds raised with around 45K in pledges.
