THT Construction Updates :

With precast wall installation phase completed, the roof phase had kick-started with ordering of structural steel. The long lead times and inspections have resulted in a 2 month delay in setting the roof. Meanwhile, the south entrance porch with handi-cap ramps and foundations for all



other entrances have been poured and completed. We hope to finish the roof phase by December and then kickstart the interiors, electrical, plumbing, windows and doors for the temple needed for Occupancy in the final phase.
