### **COVID-19 Vaccine**

It has officially been a year since the first case of COVID-19 was recorded in Wuhan, China. Since then the virus has spread around the world reshaping how we go about our daily lives. In the past couple of months, the pandemic has gotten drastically worse with a rapid increase in recorded cases. Luckily, there is good news, as there are currently 50+ vaccines in development around the world. Of those vaccines there are currently 2 in the US that are being distributed. They are the Moderna Vaccine and Pfizer-BioNtech Vaccine. They both have roughly the same efficiency with the Moderna Vaccine being 94.5% effective and the Pfizer-BioNtech Vaccine being 95% effective. They also both require 2 doses but Moderna is 4 weeks apart while Pfizer-BioNtech is 3 weeks. The vaccines are a sign of good things to come and hopefully we can move past this pandemic.
